Average Administrative Fees

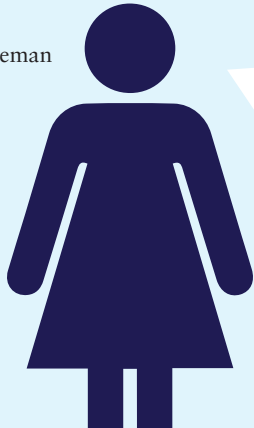


2014 Leadership

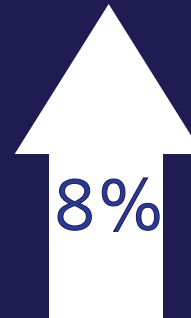
