- 1) A one page essay on why the student wants to study agriculture/education, and what individual has had the single most impact on the student's choice of study area;
- 2) A transcript of the student's grades in high school; and
- 3) A summary of the student's school/community/church/volunteer activities.

The scholarship will be selected in May of each year, but not awarded until after the completion of the first grading term during the recipient's first year of post-high school education. The scholarship recipient must earn a minimum of 2.5 GPA or above at an accredited post-high school educational institution. The scholarship will be paid when the recipient submits a copy of their transcript to the MCF.
